Abu Dhabi Entry Rules for COVID:

- 1) For delegates who have residency in the UAE and carry a UAE number, it is recommended to download the Al Hosn App, which can be downloaded via <u>https://alhosnapp.ae/en/home/</u>:
 - Vaccinated travelers must receive a negative PCR test result every 14 days to maintain 'Green' status.
 - Anyone who is unvaccinated must take a PCR test every 48 hours to maintain 'Green' status on the Al Hosn app
- 2) For visitors, no PCR or Antigen test is required to enter Abu Dhabi if you're fully vaccinated. However, it is mandatory to show a negative PCR test result to attend meetings, events, or if you wish to enter public places (malls, restaurants, etc.) taken within the last 14 days.
- 3) If you are not fully vaccinated, you must provide a negative PCR test result taken within 48 hours of your scheduled entry date. To attend meetings, events or to enter public places (malls, restaurants, etc.), the PCR test results should not be taken for more than 48 hours.

Note:

- Fully vaccinated means 2 doses for all vaccine types except for Sinopharm vaccine, you need 2 doses + booster shot to be considered fully vaccinated.
- If you are not fully vaccinated, you have to take a PCR test every 48 hours while in Abu Dhabi if you wish to enter public places (malls, restaurants, etc.) or attend meetings or events.
- PCR test cost 40 AED in Abu Dhabi Airport, and 150 AED in the hotel
- PCR test validity for vaccinated people is 14 days, and 48 hours for non-vaccinated. (Within this period of time, you can move freely in Abu Dhabi).
